Part A. Opening

Part B. New Business –

1. The All Saints' Pastoral Council has spent time the last couple of months looking at the ways that we can involve our parishioners in their parish even more. At the January meeting, we made a list of events. We will need more details to include the start and end dates of the activities, the frequency of meetings, the target audience and who is attending. We will need to add Adoration and the Beauty in Christ Women's Conference.

He suggested having a personal witness talk at the ambo next year to promote CEW. From August 2025 – Present time, there have been four people who have gone through OCIA. Bob meets with them monthly. The parish has supplied google sheets with all of the supporting committees as well as information about the committees. The Pastorate map will be announced during the second week in April.
